6.1 The Clerk's timesheet was approved.

Cllr Swift discussed the possibility of spending the money on something else as the bus shelter and groundwork are very expensive.

The Council has researched the possibility of purchasing a VAS sign. This would need approximately £2,650. This is on hold until March.
