947 Minutes of council meeting of 8th May 2017

The Chair agreed the minutes of the meeting of 8th May 2017.

The Chair signed the minutes and the Clerk added them to the minute book.

948 Code of Conduct and the Ethical Framework

949 Actions from the last meeting

949.1 The Clerk's timesheet was approved.

949.2 Monthly inspection of Council owned land

All Council Land was inspected. The bench on the green at the corner of High Lane has rotted and needs replacing. A new bench has been ordered and the Chair offered to pick it up on Tuesday 20th June

949.3 Budget –bus shelter, VAS sign

The Council considered the possibility of having a bus shelter at the bus stop near the garage travelling towards Kirkbymoorside. The Clerk contacted highways to inquire about the feasibility of this project and what type of bus shelter we could have and also

would it be possible to move the bus stop to Colley Pond. Councillor Edwards submitted a quote for the job of £5,200 exc of vat.

The Chair agreed to speak to Mr Clements about building a bus shelter similar to the one on the green. This would be a longer term project due to the expense.

This project will be considered after the Council has researched the possibility of purchasing a VAS sign. This would need approximately £2,650.

Councillor Windress to investigate further into NYCC policy.

949.4 Mobile Mast

A company are considering land at the Quarry.

The company raised its offer to £32,500.

There is a private landowner interested in this offer as well as the Council and the regional manager has said this may take a few months before we hear anything.

Councillor Windress will ask RDC solicitor if he could help with this arrangement.

A new application has also been received with a new location next to the wood on the north side of Nawton on private land. The Clerk contacted the company suggesting the alternative location at the quarry. The company replied that other sites were considered but were too far away.

The Council have received a planning application and all Councillors have commented.

949.5 The Council asked the Clerk to enquire whether the bank account at HSBC could be transferred to the Nationwide. The Nationwide reported that they do not take on Parish Council accounts. It was decided to remain with HSBC for the time being.

949.6 Kim Nicolson, who was the former clerk, wants to get rid of the big filing cabinet that is in her garage. It has old minutes and documents in it. I cannot take it as I have no room anywhere. Councillor Edwards agreed to move the filing cabinet to his shed on Highfield Lane. The Clerk was asked to look through the documents to see what needed to be kept.

949.7 A parishioner asked if we could request that Phil Gospel strimmed around the crocus' to give them a better chance of survival the next year. The Clerk to remind Mr Gospel next year and to ask him to strim as much as possible around the daffodils.

949.8 The Council asked the Clerk to initiate Tree Preservation Orders on the trees in front of the field opposite the recreation field.

949.9 The subsidence at the top of Station Road has been filled in.
