Update on the grant- unfortunately due to the thousands of requests the money has run out and we cannot access the fund but they are offering

If you would still like to apply for a defibrillator, the British Heart Foundation has an alternative funding programme offering a public access defibrillator and CPR kit (no cabinets) for which we request a contribution of £400 per defibrillator. This scheme will be available from April 2016 onwards and is available to everyone who meets the BHF criteria apart from private companies, schools and GP or dental practices. The application form for this will be available online in April. Please do let us know if you would like to be notified when this funding programme opens again so that you can submit a new application.

The Clerk was instructed to look into the price of a cabinet and to inform BHF of our interest
