843 Minutes of council meeting of 21 March 2016

The Chairman agreed the minutes of the meeting of 21st March 2016.

845 Actions from the last meeting

845.1 The Clerk's timesheet was approved.

845.2 Monthly inspection of Council owned land

All Council Land was inspected and there were no issues to report.

845.3 **Dementia Friends**

The Clerk contacted Beadlam Council who said they would share it around the village they asked if we had contacted Omega Barn. April 28th at 7.00pm has been booked for the dementia meeting in the pavilion. Posters will be circulated and a notice on the website.

845.4 **Grass cutting**

The Clerk received a phonecall from NYCC informing us that we would be receiving the sum of £315 for cutting areas that were recognized as necessary for a clear view of the roads. The Council agreed to ask Phil Gospel to trim opposite Kirkdale Manor at the end of autumn

845.5 **Dog Fouling**

Dog fouling was reported in the fields where the footpaths are; across from Pinfold Hill and the field over to Beadlam. The Clerk ordered a dog bag holder to be placed next to the dog waste bin at the start of the Howl. The Beadlam Council agreed to share the cost of the bags

Mike Jackson kindly offered to erect the holder. The Clerk asked Bob Leete to make a metal pole. This is now in place.

845.6 **Calverts**

Lorries are continuing to go left down Station Road and having to reverse out. John Windress will deal with this. This will be resolved in the near future. The Clerk was asked to contact Highways to replace the damaged sign 'Ashton Green'

845.7 **Marr Pond**

The Clerk was asked to organise the planting of 2 Birch trees at Marr Pond. They have now been planted. It was suggested another tree may need to be planted. The Council will look again at this in the autumn.

845.8 **Flower borders**

The Clerk put a notice on the website asking if anyone would be interested in submitting a tender for developing a border of flowers along the walls of the grass areas.
