961 Agenda

The agenda for the meeting had been displayed on the Nawton Parish Council notice board since 5th September and also on the website.

Councillor Debbie Swift was elected to start the meeting.

962 Parishioner presentation

It was reported that the grass cutting was very messy around the village and that it was an eyesore. The long grass was left in clumps and some cut so short it left bare earth. The Clerk was asked to get dates when Phil Gospel comes to cut the grass and ask Phil Gospel to put the dates on the bill so it is clear for auditing purposes.

963 Minutes of council meeting of 17th July 2017

The Chair agreed the minutes of the meeting of 17th July 2017.

965 Actions from the last meeting

965.1 The Clerk's timesheet was approved.

965.2 Monthly inspection of Council owned land

All Council Land was inspected. Cllr Edwards reported that one of the birch trees had been broken and would need replacing in the autumn.

965.3 Budget –bus shelter, VAS sign

The Clerk contacted highways to inquire about the feasibility of moving the bus stop near the garage to Colley Pond to facilitate a bus shelter. Councillor Edwards submitted a quote for the job of £5,200 exc of vat.

Mr Clements to submit a quote for a bus shelter similar to the one on the green. This would be a longer term project due to the expense. This project will be considered after the Council has researched the possibility of purchasing a VAS sign. This would need approximately £2,650.

Councillor Windress to call Cllr Don Mackenzie regarding NYCC policy.

965.4 Mobile Mast

A company are proposing a location for a telephone mast behind Calverts carpets. The Councillors have looked at the document and they agreed that it was the only place that was central to the village and therefore were in favour of it.

965.5 Filing cabinet

The Clerk has sorted through the documents and informed Cllr Edwards that the cabinet is ready to be moved from Kim Nicholson's shed to his workshop on Highfield Lane.

965.6 Tree Preservation order

The Council asked the Clerk to initiate Tree Preservation Orders on the trees in front of the field opposite the recreation field. The Clerk contacted Don Davies and supplied a map to identify the area. A tree evaluation method for preservation orders has been submitted. See APPENDIX1

965.7 Kissing gates

It was reported that the two kissing gates located at Gale Lane footpath crossing over to the next field are both rotten. The Clerk has reported this to Public Rights of Way at NYCC. The Clerk has requested an update.

965.8 Speeding

It was suggested that a gate entrance into the village, located on the verges may act as a symbol to slow down traffic.
