797 Actions from the last meeting

797.1 The Clerk's timesheet was approved.

797.2 Monthly inspection of Council owned land

All Council Land was inspected and there were no issues to report.

797.3 Wolds View

Following on from a complaint from a parishioner about an extension to a roof at Wold's View, this has yet to be assigned to anyone at RDC. Still has not been assessed due to lack of staff. Ongoing

797.4 Housing

Proposed development of 27 houses in the field next to Beckett Close.

A draft letter has been drawn up to help with the objection process. This may need to be amended when the application is received.

No update on this as yet.

797.5 Site Development Document

This document will be out at the end of September. We will then have six weeks to study it and respond possibly on line. This document is out but the Council has not received a copy as yet. Mr Windress said we should have received it and he would look into it.

797.6 Libby Capstick

John Purcell has received 3 quotes for a tree, the best coming from the Daisy garden centre. It was agreed that a small tree had a better chance of survival and the cost would be about £35. The Council will get a quote from them to carry out the work ie compost, rooter, stake and planting.

797.7 Pinfold Hill

Andrew Edwards was asked to remove the waste bin and the Council will observe the situation.

797.8 Bridleway and Paths

797.8.1

The Clerk has contacted Brian Simpson, Highways and Public rights of way. Graham Ward said after looking at the issue, that he would create a work order to clear the roadside gripps. This is being done on Tuesday 20th. He asked that we should assess the situation on Wednesday after an expected rainfall over night.

He said it would cost a lot of money to put it right if service pipes were exposed. The Clerk to contact the landowners Bill Harrison and John Halkon for permission to do work on the verge..

797.8.2 Diversion Order

There is a public path diversion order to divert the public footpath running from West Sleightholme Dale Farm to Aumery Park to allow erection of a new shed. See map. There were no comments.

Joe Gregory discussed the possibility of the Council taking on the Neighbourhood Plan. It was suggested that we look into whether we would have to include Beadlam or if we could just do a plan for Nawton.

Michael Jackson reported on the state of a lamppost at the top of Chapel Street which is in a rusty condition. Initially The Chair reported that the lamppost in question is a main structure for power cables. It was noted that on Monday 26 the power is going to be turned off from 9-5. The Clerk will talk to the engineers to see what they think.

Fracking information has been published on the website. The Clerk has had several comments about what the Parish Council is doing about it. The Chair said that we should monitor the situation.
