**204 Minutes of council meeting of 17<sup>th</sup> February 2020**

**206 Actions from the last meeting**

206.1 The Clerk's timesheet was approved and signed by the Chair.

206.2 Monthly inspection of Council owned land

All Council Land was inspected. It was noticed that the trees along A170 opposite the Recreation Ground had been trimmed and the bushes removed.

206.3 VAS Sign

The Clerk has received notification that £2,500 has been deposited into the bank. The Clerk has received the monitoring form which will need to be filled in within 12 months. A visit from Darren highways, took place on the 3<sup>rd</sup> March to ascertain position of the VAS. The Clerk was instructed to send a letter to highways to initiate the speed survey and suitability of telegraph pole to which the sign will be attached.

206.4 Pot holes on Chapel Street

The Clerk reported the potholes on Chapel Street. These have been repaired.

#### 206.5 Draft contract re electric sub station

The Clerk received the draft contract which was sent to the solicitor from NPG. The Council agreed that the recommendations from our solicitor should be adhered too and the clauses remain, and that she should contact NPG to emphasise that the contract stands as is. The solicitor has received the document back from NPG and is giving it her attention

#### 206.6 Grass cutting

The Clerk contacted other organisations regarding a grass cutting tender. The Clerk received correspondence from two companies –one for £110 and the other did not provide a service any more, a further inquiry did not reply. It was agreed to offer the contract to Mr Mennel.

#### 206.7 Safety Barrier and 20mph sign

The Council will look at installing a barrier on the pavement at the bottom of the school snicket in order to stop children running onto the road. The Council discussed what sort of barrier should be installed. The Chair will discuss with Mr Nichols about repairing their fence.

With reference to the 20mph sign, Highways said that they would have to do a speed survey, however such are the road conditions on that stretch of road that it would be unlikely that if such a survey be conducted the result would justify a reduction of the speed limit.
