320 Actions from the last meeting

321.1 The Clerk's timesheet was approved and signed by the Chair.

321.2 Monthly inspection of Council owned land

All Council Land was inspected. Form filled in and weather conditions taken into account. Weather conditions for May were mainly wet.

321.3 Highways

a) Flooding was an issue over winter along Howldale Lane. The Clerk has not heard back from highways as yet. Highways commented that the problem was mainly pathways/bridleways but they have done work by the memorial hall and have cleared the 3 drains along Howldale Lane

b) The Clerk spoke to a highways officer who came to look at Gale Lane. He said that it was due for resurfacing this year but with the cuts to North Yorkshire

Council they have to postpone re surfacing until the next year. Meanwhile they will repair potholes and damage areas.

321.4 Vociferous Noise

A parishioner has brought up the noise disturbance from the Rose and Crown. The Council discussed this. The music licence approved by Ryedale Council allows music inside and outside once a month. Queries or complaints must be made to Ryedale Council.

It was noted that the manager has tried to get the customers to go inside but they prefer to stay outside.

If there is no improvement the next step would be to get in touch with environmental health.

321.5 The substation

The Clerk has been in touch with the solicitor and she said that NPG will not answer her emails. This has been the case since February. She proposes to send them an invoice and ask if this case is now closed. Councillors discussed this and proposed that NPG should be given notice of 3-6 months and then The Council will withdraw their offer.

321.6 Donation to wildlife garden

It was agreed to send a donation of £50 to the wildlife garden project.

It was suggested that they ask the cricket/ Beckett Recreation Ground for money to repair the damage they did to the garden.

The request for tenders for tree work has expired. The Clerk received one application from Brian Simpson. The Clerk will email Mr Simpson to accept his application.
