**442 Actions from the last meeting**

442.1 The Clerk's timesheet was approved and signed by the Chair.

442.2 Monthly inspection of Council owned land

All Council Land was inspected. Form filled in and weather conditions taken into account. Weather conditions for October were mild with some rain.

442.3 Grant for parish councils

After many hours trying to agree the signage for the village, with consultation with the Chair, it was agreed to abandon the signage for the time being. At a later date the Council could ask highways to come out and specify what the village would be allowed to do. The six foot gate with a sign that would be too small to see was thought to be unsuitable. Councillors were asked to comment but there was no response.

The Chair stated that decisions are made by the whole Council not just The Chair and responses from all Councillors are necessary.

In the circumstances, to avoid losing the opportunity to apply for the grant, the Chair reluctantly took the decision to apply for the grant to cover the cost of an extension to the bulb planting programme started some years ago. This does not require approval from the highways authority and will enhance the village in springtime.

The Council wish to thank Cllr Jackson for his help.

The Clerk has asked for quotations from Suppliers and contractors for bulbs, turf lifter and gardener.

The Council agreed to provide a sign 'Caution Children Playing' for Station Road. This has now been erected by Cllr Jackson.

442.4 The Clerk to request grit bins on Hallfield Lane Nawton. The Clerk has reported this issue to NYCC highways. This has not been delivered as yet.

#### 442.5 Pavements

A parishioner has requested that the pavements in the village need sweeping as grit and debris could be hazardous. The Clerk is waiting to hear from highways

#### 442.6 Request to plant small tree

A parishioner has requested permission to plant a small tree on the semi circle grass area beside his house on the corner of High Street. The Council agreed to the planting of the tree. The Chair signed the tree planting Licence.
