529 Minutes of council meeting of 16th October 2023

531 Actions from the last meeting

531.1 The Clerk's timesheet was approved and signed by the Chair.

531.2 Monthly inspection of Council owned land

All Council Land was inspected. The weather conditions were taken into account. Weather conditions for October were initially mild and dry but turned very wet and muddy in mid October with storm Babet

531.3 Audit recommendations

The external auditor recommends that the website be updated and standing orders and financial regulations should be updated. In the light of the fact that NYC are publishing new guidance concerning Council websites and GPDR, the Council agreed to wait for the guidance before taking action. The Chair contacted a member of the former RDC for advice who confirmed the current website does not need to be replaced, just updated. Clerk has updated Standing Orders. Chair believes there is currently nothing further to do.

531.4 Play equipment in Beckett Recreation Ground

Concerns over the condition of some of the equipment have been raised. Clerk to find out when equipment was last inspected.

The treasurer of BRG confirms that the equipment is inspected regularly and complies with insurance requirements, but he is unsure of the date of the last inspection by a national body. The trustees are due to meet to discuss the future of the play equipment due to concerns over rising costs and insurance requirements. Clerk to contact the treasurer offering to send a representative from the Parish Council to the next Trustee meeting. Treasurer has said they are waiting for a date from someone who has offered them guidance about the equipment and questioned why we want to attend. Clerk to chase for a meeting date.

531.5 Trees at Station Road/A170 turning

A member of the public has reported concerns over the trees blocking the view pulling out from Station Road into the A170. Clerk to ask highways to inspect. Highways say the trees are too far back from the A170 to cause an issue, although they will check again in the summer when they are in full leaf. Councillor to report back to the member of the public.

531.6 Street lights in Gale Lane

Concerns were raised about the street light near the Old Post Office in Gale Lane not working. Clerk to report. The light is now working.
